RECYCLING INFORMATION FOR CITY OF RILEY RESIDENTS

The response to recycling has been very good. Listed below are reminders of what items can and cannot be put in the recycling tote if you elect to sign up. Please follow these guidelines:

- Recyclables containing liquids or food residue CANNOT be accepted.
- Items should be emptied, rinsed and dried before placing in your recycling tote.
- Remove caps/tops from milk containers and soda bottles.
- All shredded paper and glass must be bagged.
- Breakdown/flatten cardboard boxes.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS TO RECYCLE INCLUDE:

- Aluminum, steel and tin cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Detergent containers
- Plastic containers #1 through #7
- Newspaper, white paper, mixed paper
- Shredded paper (must be bagged)
- Envelopes
- Cardboard
- Glass jars and bottles (no mirrors, window glass or drinking glasses)

Please do not recycle anything that is not on this list. If you're not sure if an item is acceptable, you can contact Average Joe's at 785-776-8352 or reach out to the city office, and we'll get back to you with an answer.

Putting non-recyclables in with the recycling has the potential to make the entire batch not able to be recycled. Repeated failure to abide by these guidelines will result in removal of recycling services for the offending premise.
