Burn Site Hours

Wednesday: 12pm - 8pm Saturday: 9am - 6pm Sunday: 9am - 6pm

"Flushable" wipes are **NOT** flushable. Please help us maintain an efficient sewer system.

Water Meters: Call the city office if the lid is damaged and please DO NOT open the meter pit. If a meter is damaged from unauthorized opening, the homeowner may be responsible for repairs.

Trash pick up is Monday morning. If you have large items, call Average Joe's to make arrangements for pick up (785-537-2228).

An extra fee may apply. They will not take e-waste or construction material.

Building permits are required by the City of Riley for structures including sidewalks (additions, repairs, or removals), fencing, and carports.

Before you build, check with the city about requirements.

Riley Citywide Clean-Up May 6-7, 2025 (Tuesday and Wednesday)

The City of Riley will be picking up debris that has been sorted and placed by the curb Tuesday, May 6th and Wednesday, May 7th. **Items must be <u>sorted</u> and placed by the curb <u>before</u> 5/7, or the city will not pick them up. Please make sure to not place items in front of/on top of water meters and fire hydrants.**

Lend a hand and clean up town by taking care of your residential property. This is an opportunity to get rid of unwanted items. Items **must be sorted** in the following manner, or it will not be picked up:

- Bricks, rocks and concrete
- Large furniture
- Brush and tree limbs
- Wood, plywood and lumber
- Grass and leaves (Biodegradable bags only, **NO PLASTIC**)
- Appliances (with refrigerant removed)
- Metal

NO TIRES, SHINGLES, OR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE WILL BE PICKED UP BY THE CITY

(Unacceptable items include electronics, microwaves, televisions, paint cans, tar buckets, caulk tubes, batteries, liquids, rags, books and paper, friable asbestos, & processed lumber)

DO NOT PLACE ANY ITEMS IN OR AROUND THE ROLL-OFFS THIS INCLUDES TELEVISIONS

Senior citizens: If you need help getting heavy items to the curb, please call the city office at 785-485-2802 or the city shop at 785-485-2425.

Be reasonable with what you put out for pick up. It is entirely up to the discretion of the public works department to determine what amount they can pick up. The city will not spend multiple hours at one household picking up items.

Water bills are due by the 10th of each month to avoid late charges.

Turn Around, Don't Drown Six inches of flowing water is enough to sweep a person off their feet and can cause loss of control of light vehicles. Flood water may hide dangers such as debris or areas of the road surface that may be washed out. The city does participate in FEMA's National Flood Insurance Program through the Community Rating System and you may have access to more affordable flood insurance.
